### Application

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- Apply to Internship or Leadership Development Program at your church or program

Fall Deadline – July 1<sup>st</sup> | Spring Deadline – November 1<sup>st</sup>  
Have all transcripts sent to NU (high school, previous college, Running Start or AP)

Submit SAT / ACT / RSAT scores if available
- Fill out a FAFSA at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Use NU Code: 003783
- NPP Admissions will email student and NPP Coordinator regarding acceptance decision
- Log into Eagle and NU Email account at <http://eagle.northwestu.edu/>

### Financial Aid

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- File a FAFSA for the current school year (2021-2022 FAFSA for Fall 2021 and Spring 2022)
- Confirm all documents for packaging are complete
- Return signed copy of Terms & Conditions
- Complete Master Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling Form
- Check student balance after 3-4 weeks after the start of a term

### Advising

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- NU completes Transcript Review for students with prior college credit

- NPP Academic Advisor emails proposed student schedule
- Respond to advising email, accepting your schedule within one week. Student will be registered by NU.
